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What is Green Finance?

- Green finance is any structured, financial activity — a product or service — that's been created to ensure a better environmental outcome.
- It includes loans, debt mechanisms and investments used to encourage new green projects or make traditional projects greener.
- Green finance can come from both private or government sources and, often, a combination of the two.





Natural Environment Investment Readiness Fund

Overall aim

 To Improve the financial resilience of the natural environment sector and increase the overall level of funding available by stimulating private sector investment

Provide opportunities

- for public, private and third sector investors
- for businesses
- for farmers and landowners/managers

Investment Readiness supports charities and social enterprises become ready take on investment.

- Capability and capacity development
- Business plans, structuring financial strategies, legal agreements, governance structures

- Duration < 1 year and not to go beyond 31st March 2024
- Application closing date 3rd February 2022

- 152 applications requesting £13m in funding
- 190 Defra Group staff involved in assessment
- 29 successful projects
