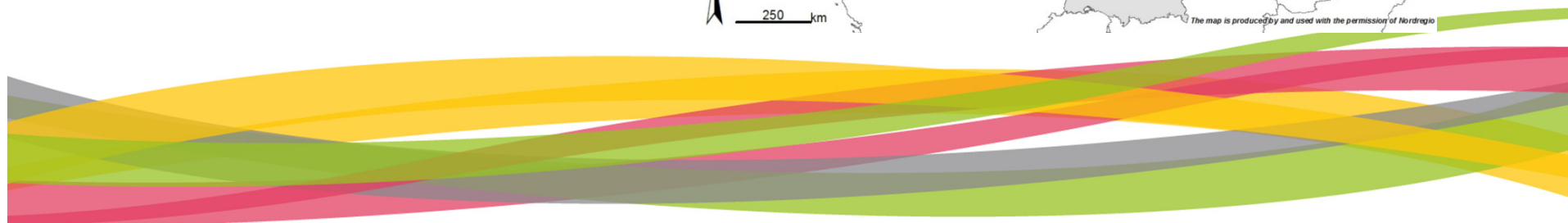


## Interreg VB North Sea Region Programme Area 2014-2020

Regions within the NSR programme area



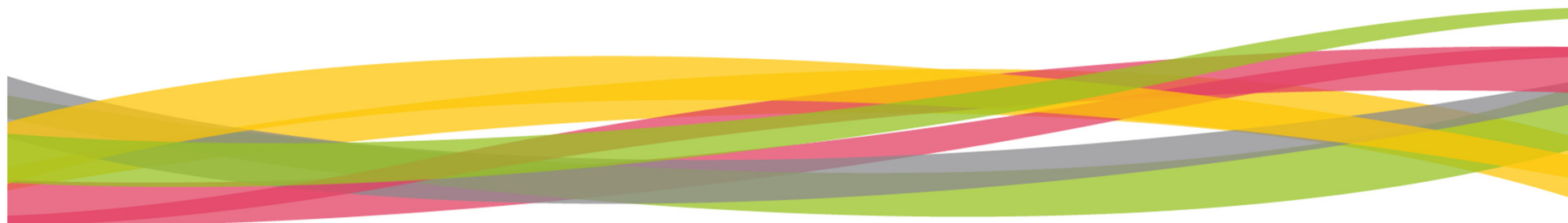

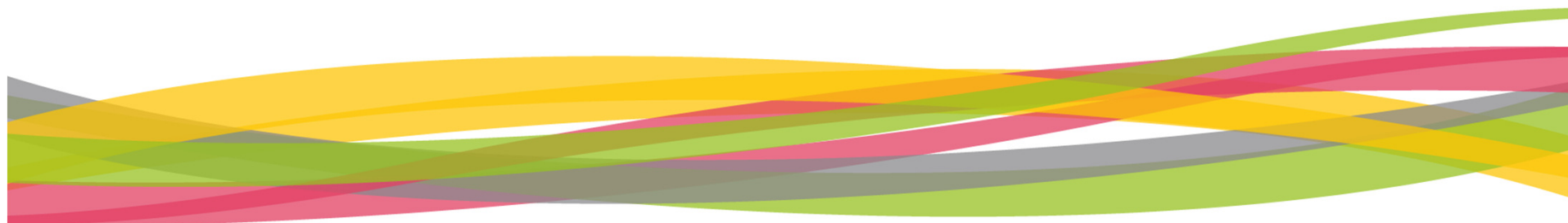




## Green transport and mobility

4.1 Develop demonstrations of innovative and/or improved transport and logistics solutions with potential to move large volumes of freight away from long-distance road transportation

4.2 Stimulate the take-up and application of green transport solutions for regional freight and personal transport



## Priority 4 project applications to date

### **Call 1 –**

5 Full Applications submitted: 3 rejected, 2 approved

10 EOIs submitted: 6 rejected, 4 approved

ERDF granted: €3,641,067

ERDF equivalent granted: €894,818

### **Call 2 –**

4 Full Applications submitted: 3 rejected, 1 approved

7 EOIs submitted: 4 rejected, 3 approved

ERDF granted: €2,197,940

ERDF equivalent granted: €425,195

### **Call 3 -**

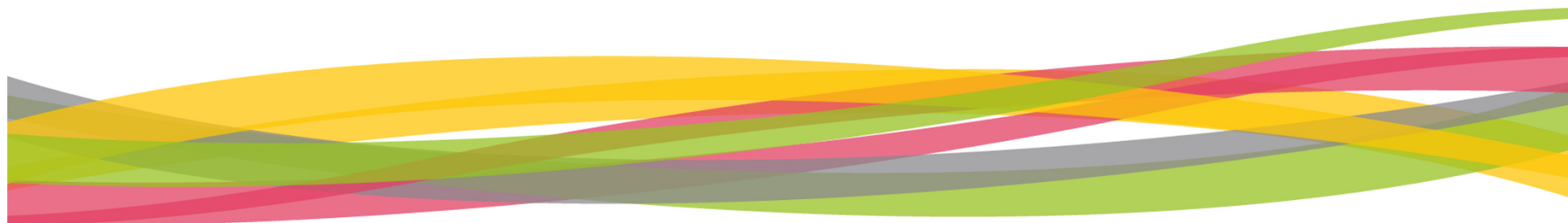
5 Full Applications submitted (2 rejected Full Applications resubmitting,  
3 EOIs)

ERDF equivalent remaining: €608,300



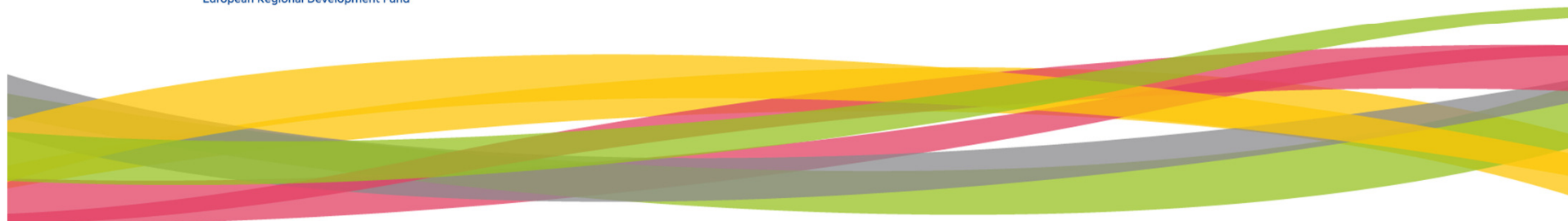

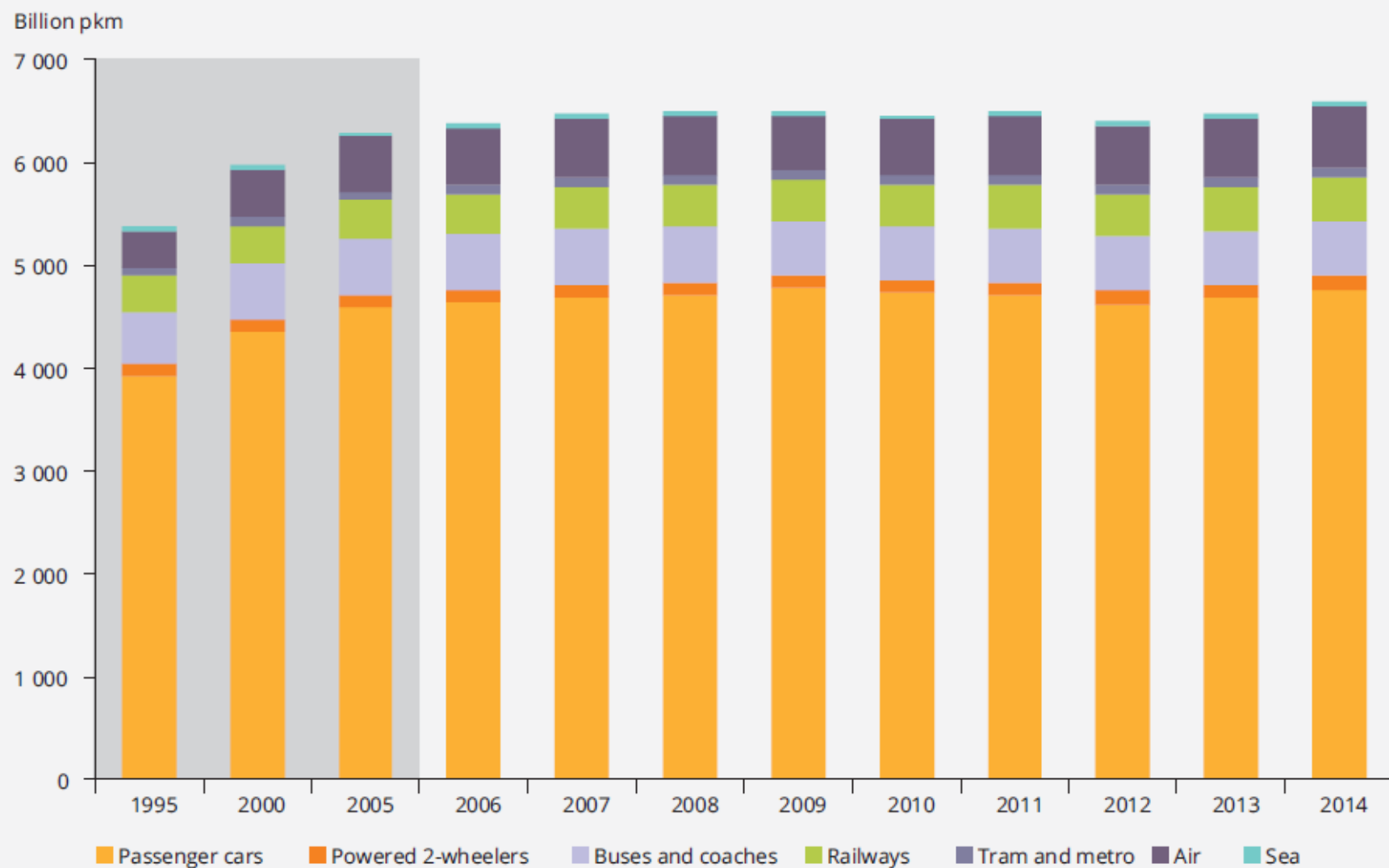

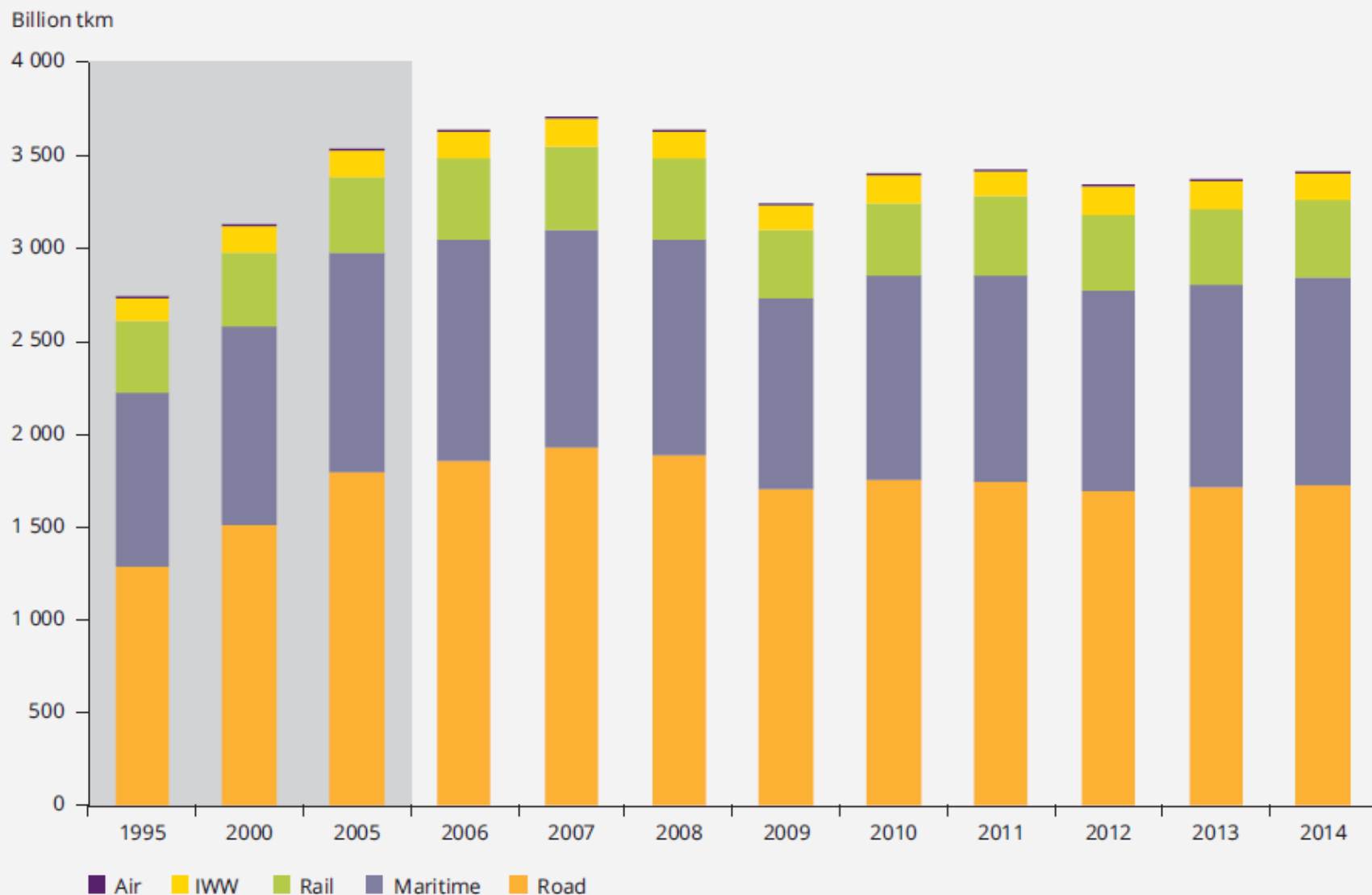
**Figure 2.7 Passenger transport volume in the EU-28**

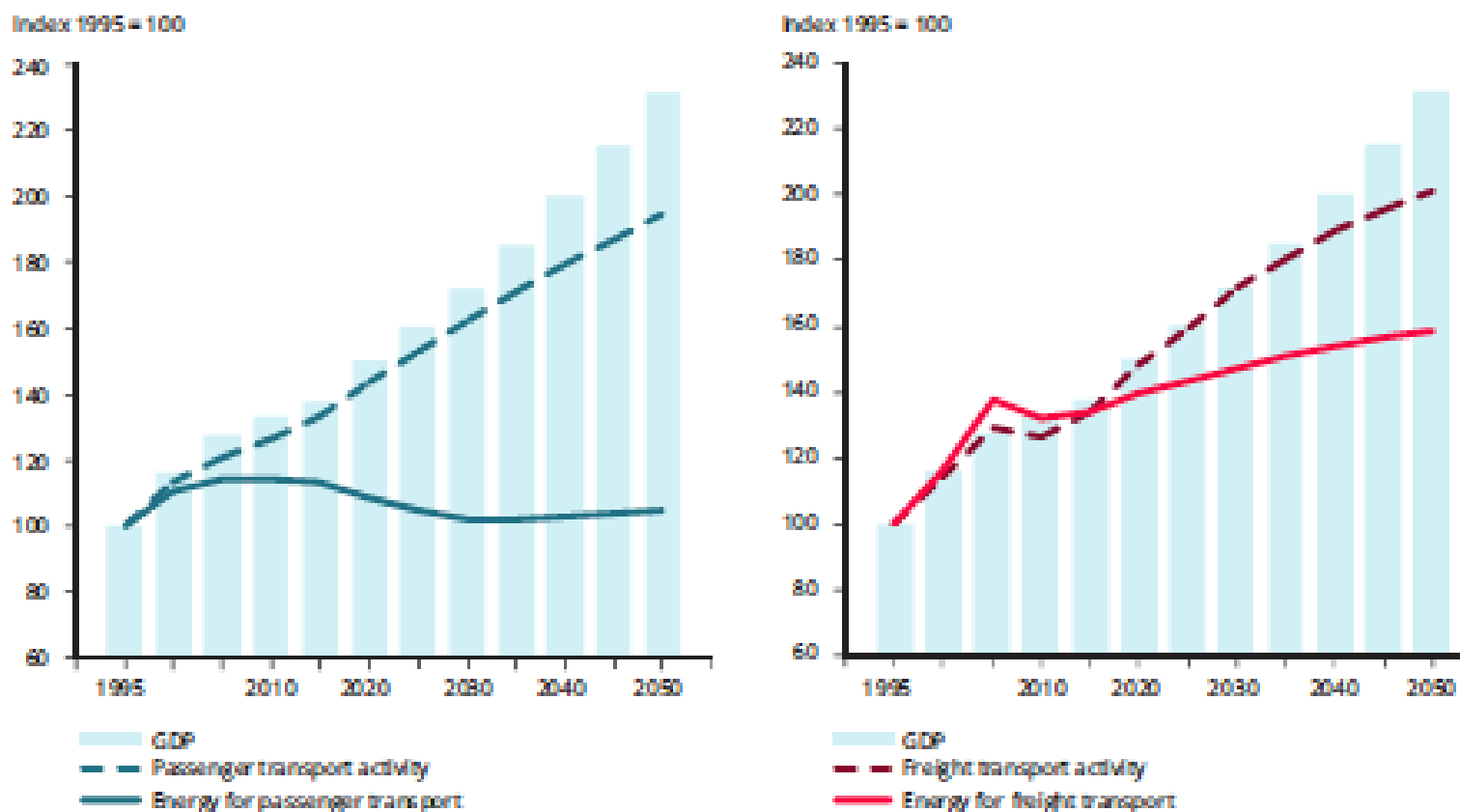
**Box 2.8 TERM 13 — freight transport volume and modal split**

**Figure 2.8 Freight transport volume in the EU-28**



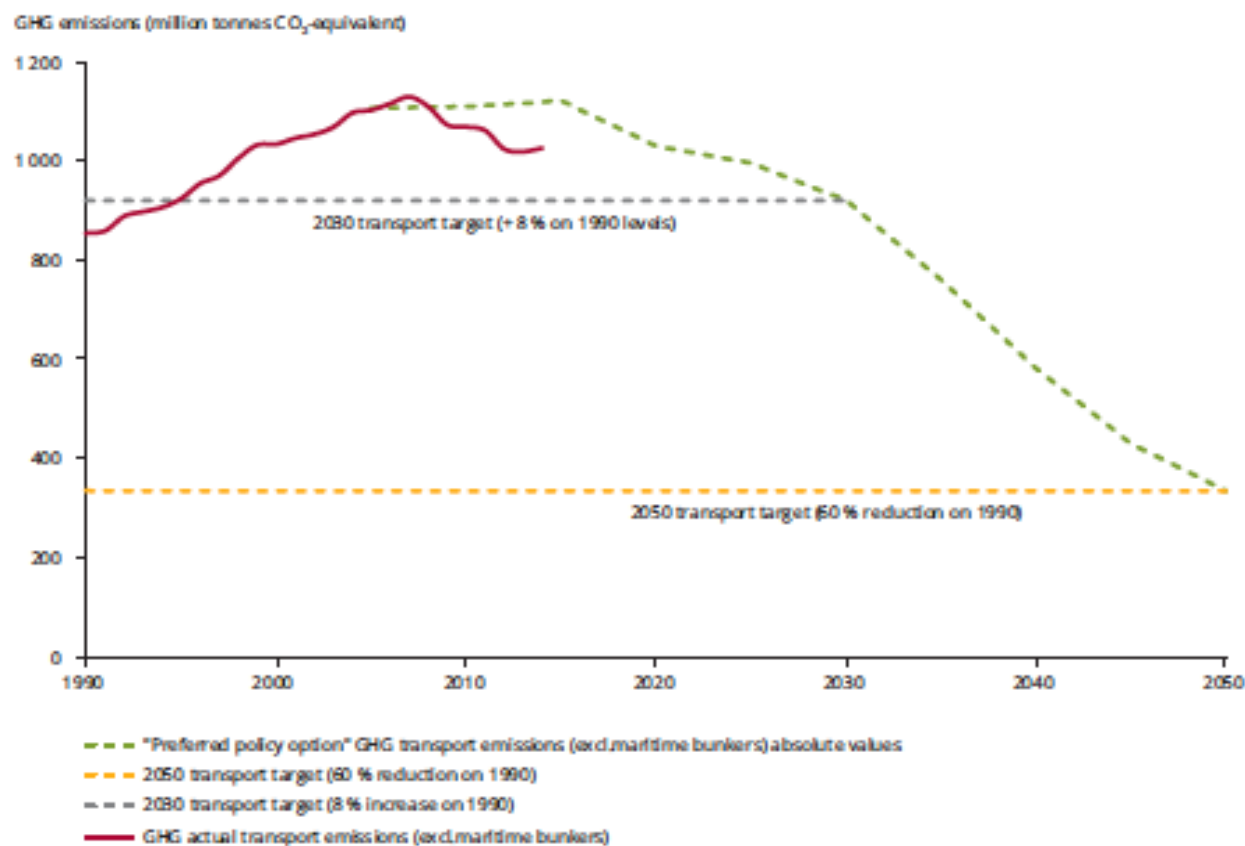

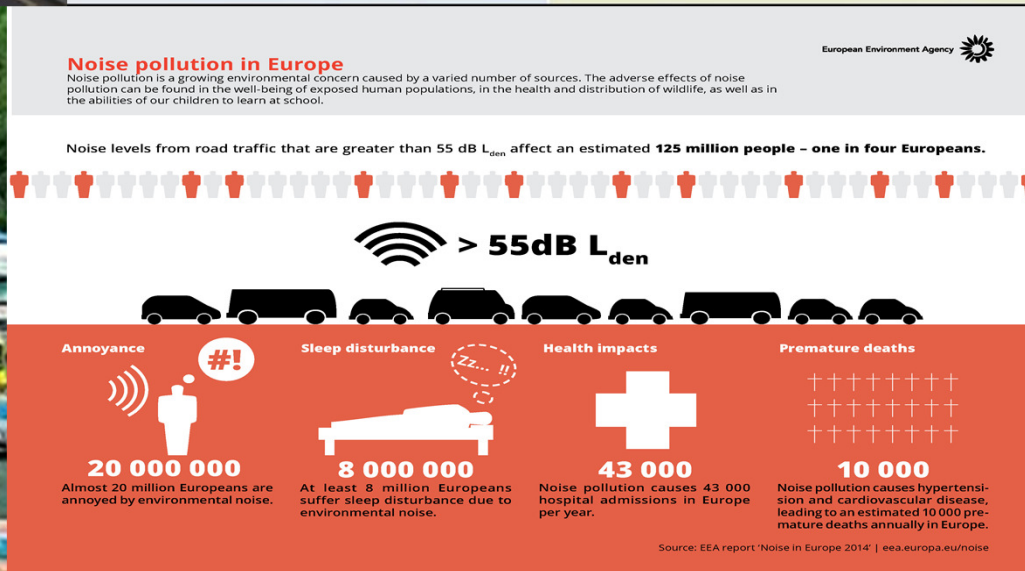
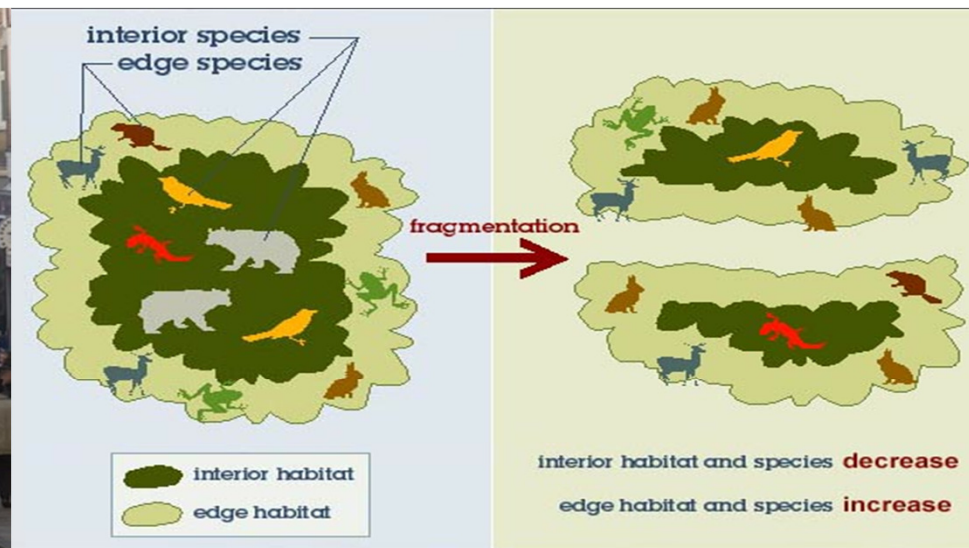
**Figure A2.1 Transport GHG emissions**
